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How many kWh does a 100 watt solar panel produce?

A 100-watt panel that operates at full capacity for an average of four hours of sunlight produces 0.4 kWh. A kilowatt-hour measures how much electrical the panel can supply. It stands for one kilowatt (or 1,000 watts) of power for one hour.
