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How does Iceland radio work?

Iceland Radio's main operation is aeronautical voice communication, which requires considerable human resource. When aircrafts are not in radar range with the oceanic control centre, oceanic en-route service is provided through voice communication to Iceland Radio. Main service provided for voice communication Aircraft position reports.

How does air navigation work in Reykjavik?

Air navigation service provision within the Reykjavik CTA uses flight data provided by radar, ground and space based ADS-B stations. Neighbouring flight information region are: The main airports within the area are Keflavik and Akureyri in Iceland, Vagar airport in the Faroe Islands and Sandrestrom and Thule airports in Greenland.

What services does Iceland radio offer?
